



LETTER OF INTENT

The purpose of this Letter of Intent is to formalize a collaborative working relationship between Prince Albert Grand Council, the Government of Canada, and the Government of Saskatchewan (collectively referred to as the "Parties") in meeting the objective of developing an implementation plan for community oriented public safety and policing, which addresses the specific community safety and protective services needs of PAGC member Nations and communities.

Prince Albert Grand Council (PAGC) is the Grand Council organization representing 12 First Nations comprised of 28 communities in northern Saskatchewan, which are organized in to four sectors: Athabasca Denesuline, Plains / Dakota Cree, Swampy Cree, and Woodland Cree.

PAGC has expressed a desire to enhance community safety planning for its member Nations. PAGC also desires to ensure effective and culturally appropriate police services within its communities.

Canada and Saskatchewan are committed to implementing the Calls for Justice from the Final Report of the National Inquiry into Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Girls. These calls for justice include all governments supporting changes that are culturally appropriate and effective within Indigenous policing from its current state.

Canada and Saskatchewan are committed to community oriented public safety and policing and working in the spirit of reconciliation with Indigenous peoples through renewed relationships based on respect, co-operation, and partnerships.

The collaborative working relationship will be established through a working group with representation from each Party; hereinafter, referred to as the PAGC Public Safety Implementation Team ("PAGC PSIT").

The Parties enter into this Letter of Intent with the purpose to collectively support the identified objective. This Letter of Intent is not a contract and does not create any legally binding or enforceable obligations between or amongst any of the Parties.

In expression of the Parties' present commonly shared intentions and objectives and their desires to conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the contents of this Letter of Intent, each has caused it to be signed by their respective representatives on the date(s) set out below:
