Yuasni Tipi Family Treatment Centre is inviting First Nations Artists from the PAGC communities to submit their artwork of a Buffalo Mural for the interior of the Yuasni Tipi Family Treatment Centre. The Yuasni Tipi Family Treatment Centre is located on the Lands of Wahpeton Dakota Nation, North/East of Prince Albert, Sask.

This mural will highlight the longstanding connection and respect First Nations people have for the Buffalo, the Land, Tipi and Ceremonies.

Submission guidelines:

- Submit your art design idea in color on letter sized paper
- Submit a written description of artwork design, its connections to the theme, and how you see the design fitting into the parameters (Approx 7 ft height x 14 ft length)

Eligibility:

- Artists must self-identify as members of one of the PAGC communities
- Artists can be emerging or mid-career
- Artists must be Alcohol and Drug Free

Requirements for selected artist:

- Complete mural by Wednesday, September 4, 2024
- Attend and be honored at the unveiling of your artwork at the Grand Opening on Friday, September 20, 2024
